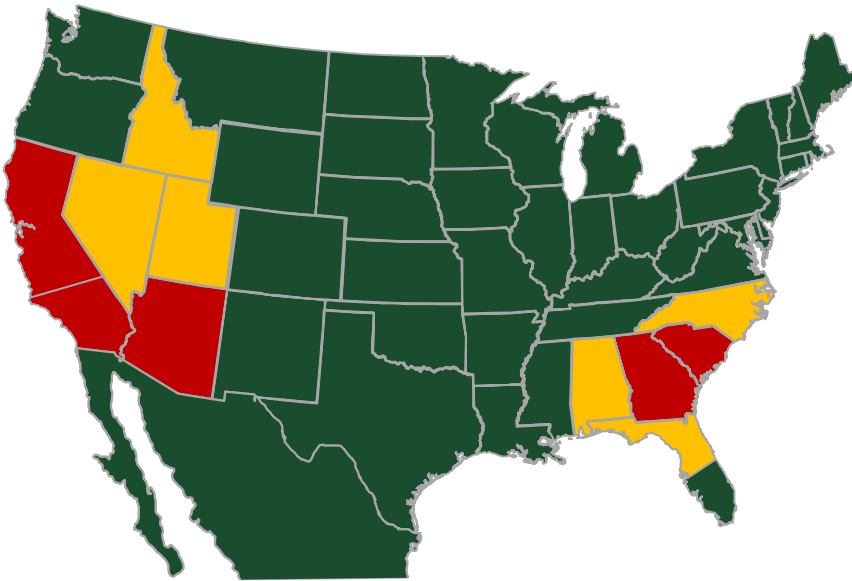

Overview/Projections

- The 4th of July push has started, and we should see rates start to increase out West as well as in the Southeast. We anticipate this will be the case through the 4th.
- With the amount of rain there has been in the Midwest it will be a late start to the produce season. Rates should stay down through July.
- AZ, CA, and GA continue to be the hardest areas to secure trucks.
- Produce is starting to move up the east coast with shippers starting in the Carolinas.



Texas

Excess capacity is available should be the case for the entire summer.



Northern California

The push for the 4th of July is starting, rates will start to creep up mid week and be at their peak over the weekend.



Southern California

Difficult area to secure trucks at the right price, Melons and Grapes shipping high volume.



Washington/Oregon

There should be a big push for cherries this week, but capacity should be able to keep up.



Idaho

Should remain stable until the fall



Arizona

Continues to be a tough area with Melons/Grapes shipping high volume.



Midwest

Excess capacity available in the Midwest continues.



Southern Florida

Most everything has shifted to shipping further north. Trucks are deadheading north to find loads



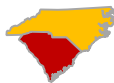
Florida/Georgia
